The Mesquite Public Health Clinic provides low cost immunizations to children eligible for the Texas Vaccines for Children Program (TVFC). The purpose of this program is to increase the immunization level among Texas Children using state and federal funds. A child 18 years of age or younger is eligible for TVFC if the child:

- Is a patient who receives benefits from the Children's Health Insurance Plan (CHIP), or
- Is enrolled in Medicaid, or
- Does not have health insurance, or
- Is an American Indian, or
- Is an Alaskan Native, or
- Is underinsured, or
- Is a patient who is served by any type of public health clinic and does not meet any of the above criteria.

Hours of Operation

8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.

The public is seen on a walk-in basis.

Cost

\$14 per child

Tuberculosis (TB) tests - \$20

Influenza vaccinations for adults - \$20

ALL RECIPIENTS MUST HAVE AN UP TO DATE SHOT RECORD PRIOR TO RECEIVING VACCINES.

ALL CHILDREN RECEIVING VACCINATIONS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN, OR AN ADULT WITH WRITTEN CONSENT FROM THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
