

FEMA- Floodplain Maps

Fema floodplain maps are available on-line. You can select a community, select a section and print (free) an 8.5" X 11" copy of the section you want. The copy will also have the panel title, and the scale. If you want the entire panel- you must order the panel from Fema (costs vary).

1. Go to www.msc.fema.gov
2. Double click on the "Looking for....." box.
3. Select Flood maps.
4. #1 select "State" (names of states are listed)
5. #2 select "County"
6. #3 select "Community"
7. #4 when your community comes up select "Find FEMA issued Flood Maps"
8. Select the Index Panel or panel you want.
9. Select "view" on the above selection.
10. When the window is visible, use the zoom tools as needed to select a portion of the map.
11. Select "Make a Firmette" button.
12. Select the paper size and move the shaded box on the map to the area you want to reproduce.
13. It is not necessary to move any of the other shaded boxes. (Title, Map Date)
14. Select the format to use in printing-Adobe or TIFF.
15. Print or save as you need.
